Overview

Kosovo A Power Station was opened in 1962. It was operated by and until. Kosovo A Power Station is a lignite-fired power station with five units in Obiliq, Kosovo. With a capacity of 650 MW, it is the second largest power station in Kosovo after Kosovo B Power Station. It is described to be the worst single-point source of pollution in Europe. Despite plans to shut the units down in 2017, it was still partially operating as of March 2025. Generation units

- Unit 1 has a generation power of 50 MW and a 120 metres (390 ft) tall chimney with a diameter of 4 metres (13 ft) at the top.
- Unit 2 has a generation power of 200 MW and a 120 metres (390 ft) tall chimney with a diameter.
