A typical home solar panel is about 3 feet wide by 5.5 feet long, occupying an area of roughly 17. If you have a 1000 sq ft roof, and you can use 75% of that roof area for solar panels, you can theoretically put 123 100-watt solar panels on a 1000 sq ft roof. To determine the area covered by each solar photovoltaic panel, several factors come into play, including the type of panel, the manufacturer, and its specific capacity. 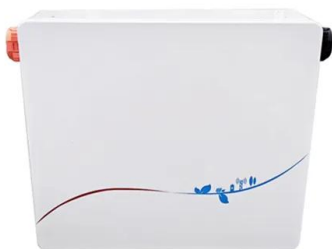

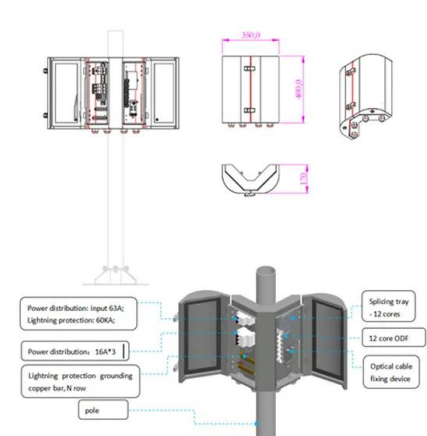
